## Write a review for the 'class blog'



Start with a short brainstorm choosing e.g., a film or a concert you would like to review.



Writing a review you have to integrate the elements: description, opinion and recommendation.




Decide on and write keywords to the content of the three elements in your review. Write your first short draft based on the keywords.



Specific language features are important to use writing a review. Write on a list in your class channel the language you already know covering examples of the note.




Prompt AI for more ideas covering the language you need to integrate. Did you get useful ideas? Add them to the list



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Look at the shared list before deciding on what language to integrate in your text. Take your first draft and integrate the specific language features into it.



Select text parts from your draft that you want feedback on from Al. Integrate the text parts in your prompt and ask for:

• sentence starter variations, synonyms, different connectives, chunks expressing opinions etc.

Try several times and use different Al's. Look at the prompt results. What can be of use? Write your final text and upload.
